



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How old do I have to be to take part?

A: There are two age brackets eligible for registration:

- Adults and children over 12 years of age can register to participate:
 - €20 online registration with **Free** T-Shirt & **Free** Entry to the Curragh Horse Racing on the day – **if you register online.**
 - Late registration is possible on the day of the event.
- Children (under 12) who want to receive a registered runner number & compete for prizes can also register at a reduced rate (€10).
- Children (under 12) can also take part for FREE but must be accompanied by a participating adult. (Children taking part for FREE are requested to start from the back & cannot compete for prizes, and will not receive a t-shirt and runner number.)

Q: How do I register?

A: Online Registrations are available. Please review the “Registration” section of the www.jogforjockeys.ie website.

Q: Where is the racecourse located?

A: The racecourse for 2018 is: The Curragh Racecourse. Directions & Map available in the “Venue” section of the www.jogforjockeys.ie website.

Q: Where do I park?

A: There is plenty of parking available at the racecourse. Runners and supporters please park in the racecourse car-park. The Venue location and google maps are available in the “Venue” section of the www.jogforjockeys.ie website.

Q: When and where is registration on the day of the event?

A: On the day of the event registration will take place during the Curragh Race Meeting on 1st September 2018. The Registration Desk will be clearly signposted.

Q: Will the course be accurately measured?

A: The course will be accurately measured by a course measurer. The race will have KM markers around the course.

Q: Will the finish times for participants be made available after the event?

A: Links to the results page with the completion times for all registered participants will be made available after the event (check back to this site after the event).

Q: When and where will the prize ceremony take place?

A: Presentations to all winners will take place after the 5k completes at approx. 18:00 (6pm).

Q: When do the races start?

A: Start time for 5k runners will begin at approx. 17:15 (5:15pm) – after the horse racing takes place.

Q: Where should I wear my race number?

A: Pin it to the front of your t shirt that you are wearing for the race with the pins provided at the registration desk.

Q: Can I run for a charity?

A: The Jog For Jockeys 5k is being run to support the Irish Injured Jockeys.

Q: Are there other ways I can help?

A: Yes, there are other ways to help. Please Contact Us to volunteer or make kind donations.

Q: Are there prizes on offer?

A: Yes the first 3 men and the first 3 women past the finish line for each race receive a prize. There will also be prizes for the children who register to compete.

Q: Can I bring a dog onto the course?

A: Unfortunately, No Dog's Allowed on the course.
